

Puppy Development Coordinator



Leader Dogs for the Blind currently has an opening for a Puppy Development Coordinator. This position manages the assignment of puppies to future raisers, coordinates the schedule for the puppies' first year, maintains regular contact with Puppy Counselors and Raisers, evaluates raiser/counselor training effectiveness, collects and analyzes data, and provides support for other areas of Puppy Development. This position will also help research, develop and implement future Puppy Raising programs within the Prison network. Local and national travel is required.

A Bachelor's degree (BA or BS) from an accredited four-year college or university or a two-year specialized training program preferred. Dog training accreditation (experience/education may be considered). A minimum of 10 years dog training experience, volunteer management experience, and previous prison program knowledge preferred.
